**FINDING FREDERICK CLASSES**

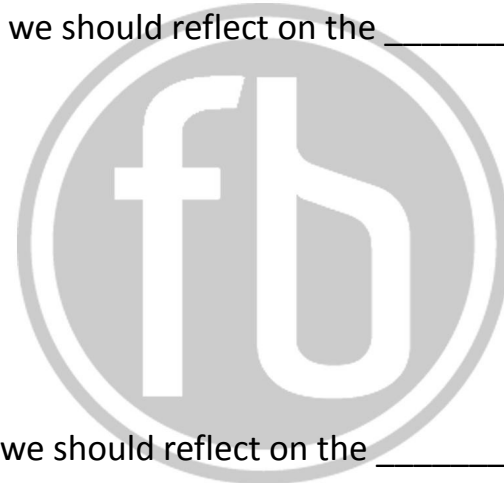
